"What If We Got It Right?" Join the next Climate discussion on January 19, 2025




inspired by each other, and support each other as we seek to live the Enduring Principle of Sacredness of Creation with greater intention and connectedness.



Free virtual workshop series for white folks

Witnessing Whiteness: The Journey into Racial Awareness and Anti Racist Action

Wednesdays, January 29 - April 2, 2025 6:00-8:00pm CT, 10 sessions

This is a 10 session workshop series designed for white people to begin and/or continue anti-racism work using the <u>Witnessing Whiteness</u> book and curriculum. We gather online in real time to dialogue and engage in experiential activities exploring the white experience.

This is an extremely interactive series where you will be asked to be on camera during the sessions. We will have large group discussions, breakout rooms for small groups and lots of personal reflection activities.

Goals of the Series

- Build a community with a shared understanding of privilege, whiteness, and racism
- Increase your ability to begin, support, and deepen racial justice work
- Develop leadership capacity around issues of diversity, inclusion, and race

What you need

- Your own copy of the third edition of the book
- Ability to participate on Zoom
- Ability to commit to regular attendance. The first and final sessions are mandatory. We ask that you miss no more than two.




